- For grace chance candidates, please collect Xerox Copy of all pass mark sheets and duly filled Grace Chance application form.
- Draft Nominal Roll incorporating the elective subjects for VI Semester (Regular/Sandwich) & VIII Semester (Part-time) fresh candidates, institution transfer, re-admission, continuation of studies, revaluation results and malpractice punishments will be made available in the FTP portal at later stage.
- Examination fee should not be collected from candidates who are debarred for the April 2021 (i.e. to be conducted in June / July 2021) Board Examination.
- Further instructions, regarding NR scrutiny will be issued in due course.
- For all regular & supplementary candidates, please collect duly filled-in registration forms and keep the same at the Institution itself.
